All the greens have been constructed to USGA specifications and sown with Penncross Bent grass which gave a consistent and excellent putting surface on the day.

After a warm welcome from the Captain of Mentmore and a light lunch, the eight matches got underway promptly under the watchful eye of Clive, our starter, and were played in glorious summer weather. Special mention should be made of the pristine team uniforms displayed by Mike Carrick and Alan Pulham - role models for all of us!

Dinner was held in the elegant restaurant and the combination of excellent cuisine, good wine and wonderful hospitality from our Buckinghamshire hosts resulted in a most memorable and delightful day.
