It now has two contrasting loops of holes. The front nine is tight and requires good course management, in particular, the long 9th with its demanding out of bounds along the right hand side. The inward nine is longer and more open with a variety of water features. The 12th is one of the finest par 3's in Worcestershire being long with the front of the green well guarded by water. The course was generally very well presented.

Our match with the Worcestershire Captains is very much a local derby because many of the Worcestershire golf clubs are close to Birmingham and also close to many of the Warwickshire clubs. Several players from both sides, therefore, knew each other well.

This was our first match of the season and we were blessed with a very warm day and splendid conditions for golf. Gaudet Luce Golf Course lived up to its name :- "Rejoice in the Light".

The teams were well led by Barry Mc Donald, Warwickshire Captain and the aptly named Worcestershire Captain, Paul Wacker. The two Presidents and long standing friends and adversaries, Roger Mann and John Bevan also did battle.
